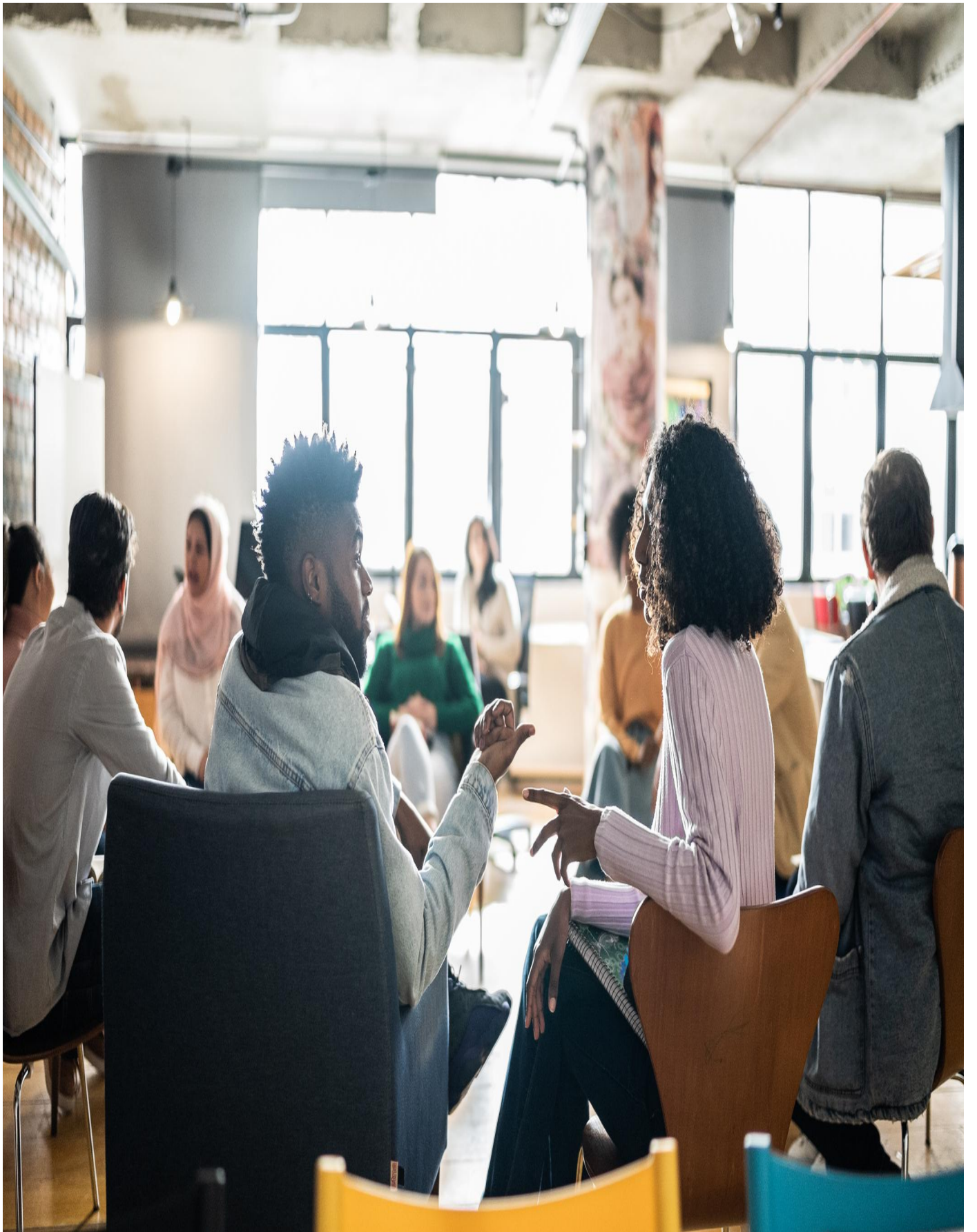
The Colorado Health Foundation is guided by the following **core values and beliefs** in pursuit of our mission:
